ANNUAL REPORT

Dear Friends!

For Kyiv, the year 2022 was meant to be a year of further dynamic development and closer alignment with the living standards of the best European metropolises. However, on February 24, the capital, like all of Ukraine, woke up to the sound of explosions from Russian missiles.

The enemy's primary target was the heart of the country – its capital. Consequently, from the very first hours of this brutal invasion, thousands of Kyiv's citizens rushed to military headquarters and Territorial Defence formations to join the ranks of the country and city defenders. Tens of thousands more participated in volunteer initiatives aimed at supporting our defenders and providing assistance to forcibly displaced persons who arrived in Kyiv.

Since that time, the city authorities have been confronted with completely different tasks, distinct from those of peacetime. These tasks include ensuring the city's survival under martial law, coordinating its defense in cooperation with the military, maintaining the stable functioning of critical infrastructure and all services, and providing all necessary assistance to Kyivites.

From the first days of the large-scale invasion, the Kyiv subway served as a refuge for tens of thousands of Kyivites, while more than 3 600 shelters accommodated approximately 3 million people simultaneously. Despite the ongoing hostilities and disrupted logistics, the city authorities managed to avert a humanitarian catastrophe by supplying food, medicine, and essential necessities to those who stayed in the city.

As a result of the massive shelling of the capital and the active fighting in the suburbs, over 700 buildings in Kyiv were damaged, including residential buildings, private houses, educational and healthcare institutions, and businesses. The enemy showed no mercy, relentlessly destroying our power and heating infrastructure. Under the electricity shortage, Kyiv relied heavily on generators to keep the city functioning. Despite this challenge, hospitals, strategically important enterprises, shops, and pharmacies continued to operate. To prevent the transportation collapse in the city, buses were rerouted to trolleybus routes.

We have gradually learned to live and work in the new realities, and as far as possible, we quickly restored and eliminated the damage after the enemy attacks. Utility workers, energy workers, and emergency services worked around the clock to restore electricity, water, and heat to the homes of Kyiv residents.

In the first days of the enemy's invasion, the settlements adjacent to Kyiv – Bucha, Irpin, Hostomel, Borodianka – bravely stood in the way of the enemy's advance towards the capital, detaining it at the cost



of incredible losses. During that critical time, Kyiv accommodated the wounded in the capital's medical institutions, provided aid in clearing rubble and repairing destroyed houses, resettled residents of nearby communities in the capital, and sent humanitarian aid to the occupied areas. Upon the liberation of Irpin from the Russian occupiers, Kyiv specialists played a vital role in swiftly restoring the city's water supply. The capital also provided financial assistance for the reconstruction of eight communities in the Kyiv region that suffered the most from the atrocities of the Russian invasion in February–March 2022.

Great Kyiv withstood the onslaught: the test that we passed with the Kyiv Region in the first days and weeks of the war, proved that the Kyiv City Agglomeration is a true brotherhood, bound by mutual aid and support.

After the liberation of the Kyiv region from the occupiers, life gradually returned to Kyiv. Many people were able to return to their homes, and businesses resumed their operation with increased intensity. Traditionally, a full-fledged educational process began in the capital on September 1. Throughout the year of war, Kyiv provided refuge for more than a quarter of a million internally displaced persons. The birth of 16 461 babies served as a symbol of Kyiv and Ukraine's revival and future, making it a true gift for the capital.

Thus, Kyiv withstood the challenges, and Ukraine will also withstand. Every day, together, we bring our just Victory closer and closer.

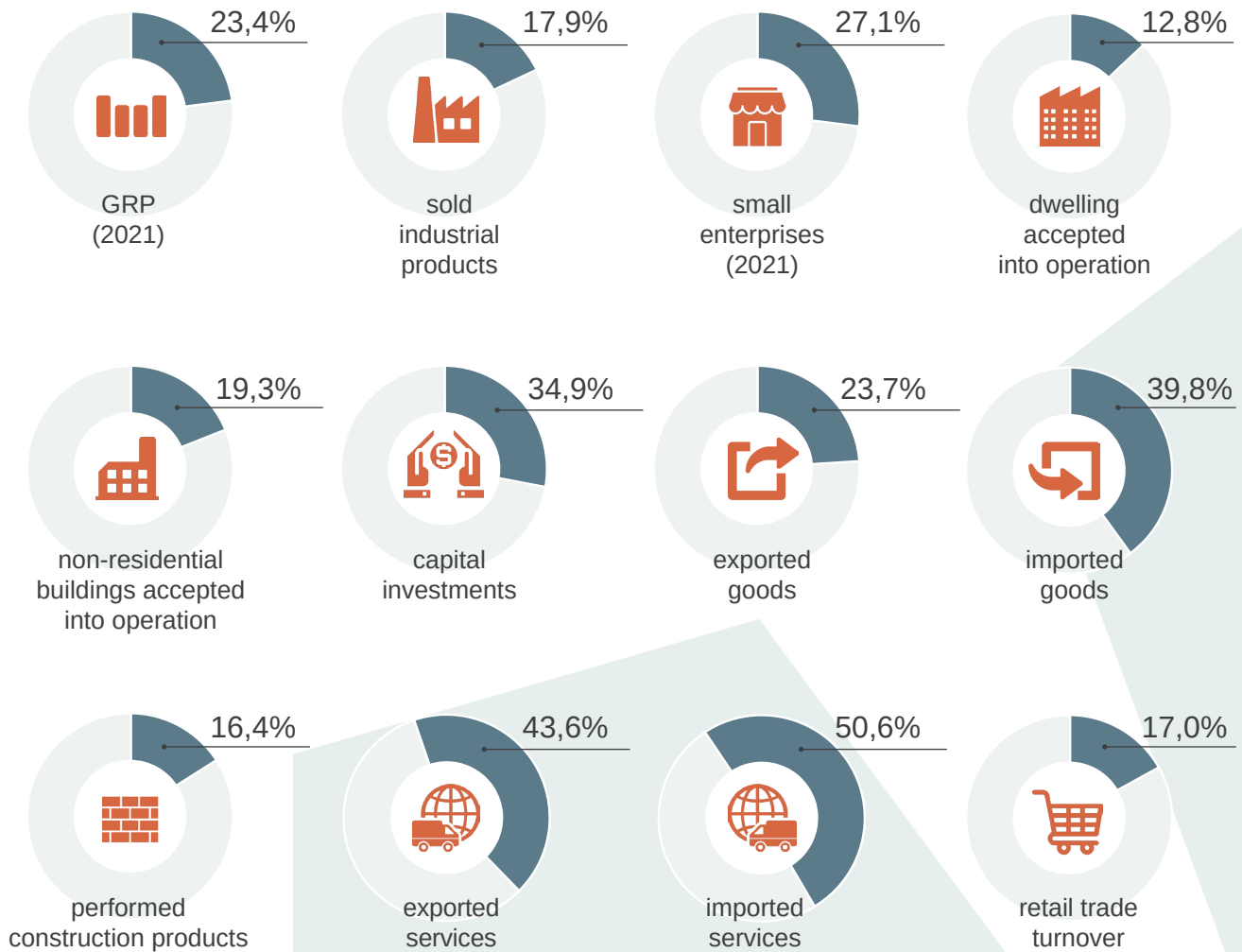

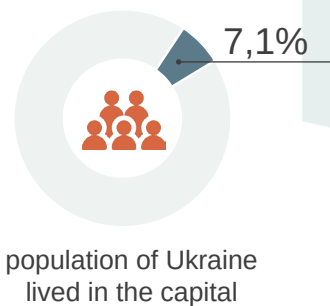

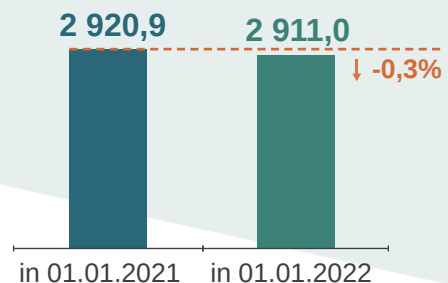
The share of Kyiv in the economy of Ukraine in 2022

The number of permanent population in Kyiv at the beginning of the year, thousand people

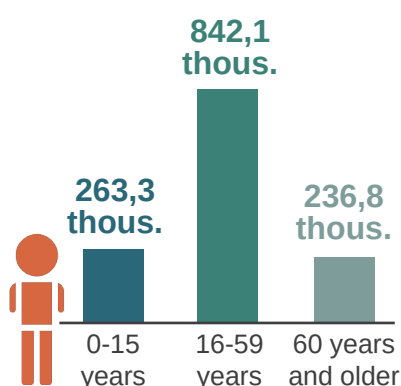
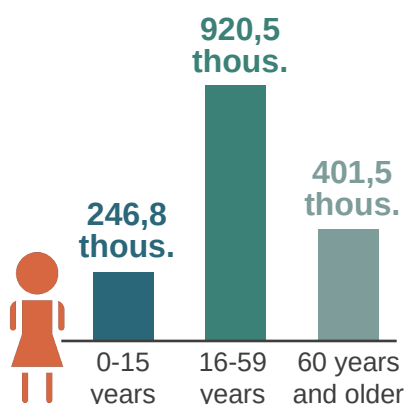
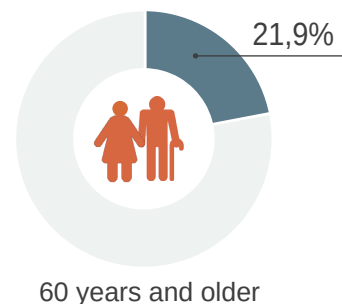
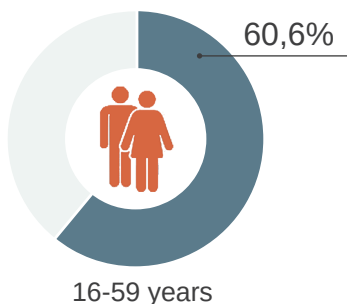
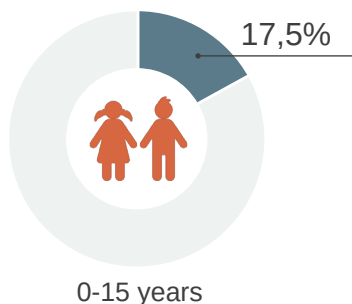

In February-March 2022, immediately after the full-scale invasion of Russian Federation in Ukraine, 44% of Kyiv citizens left Kyiv¹. At the end of 2022, there were almost as many citizens in Kyiv as before the war²

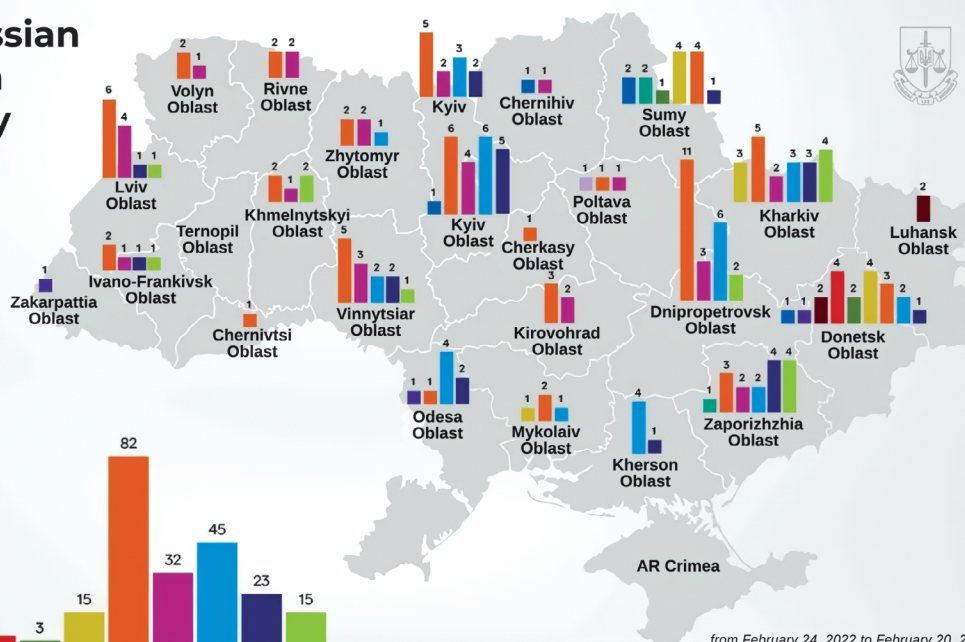

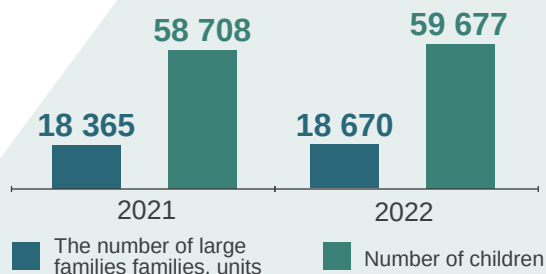

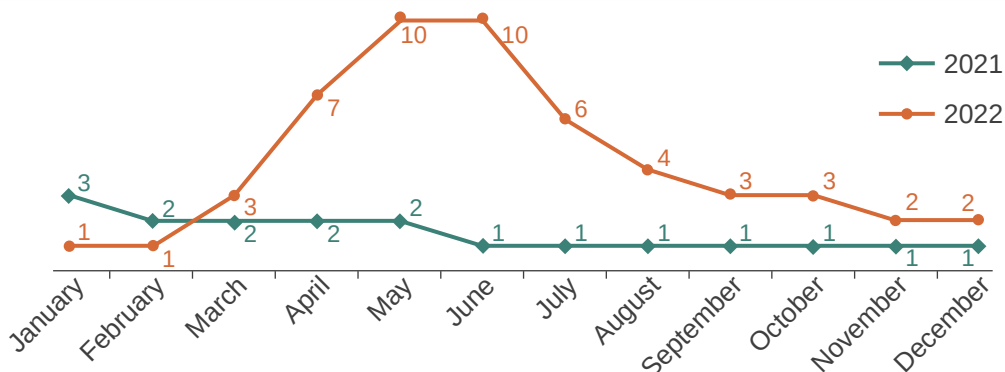

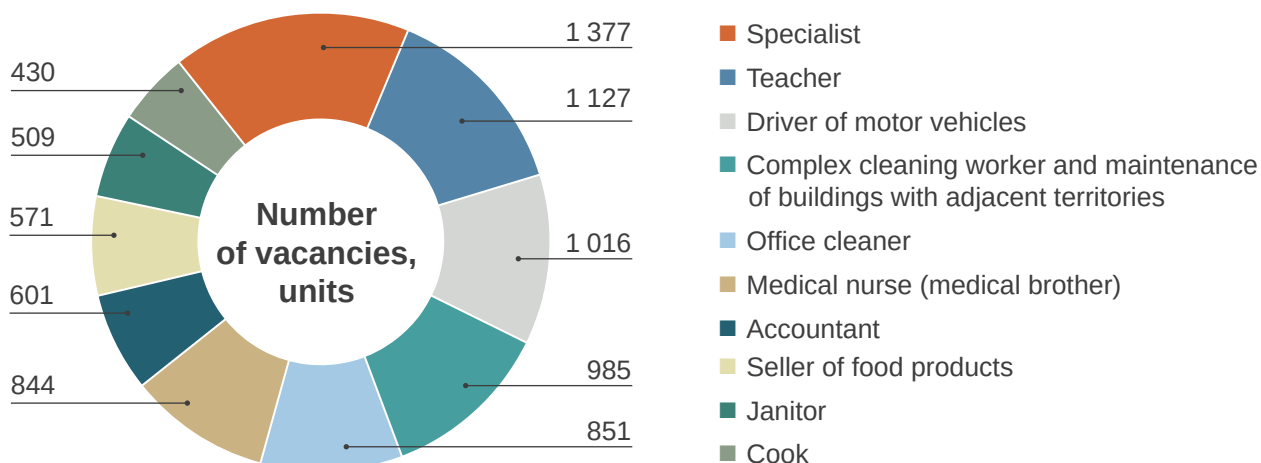
SITUATION IN THE LABOR MARKET IN KYIV

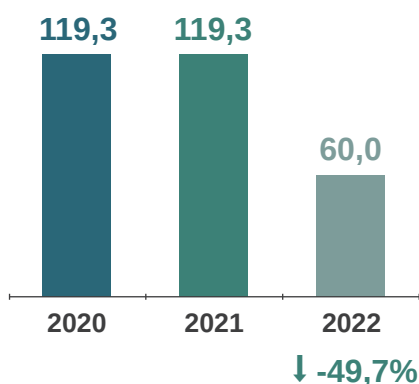

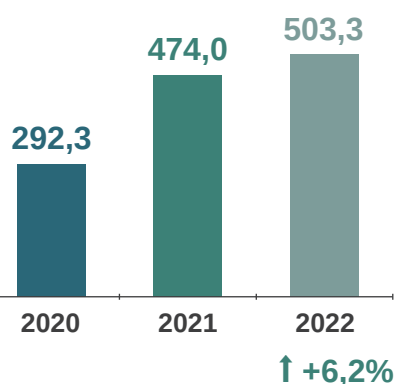

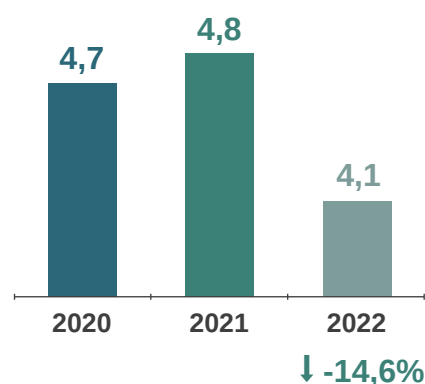

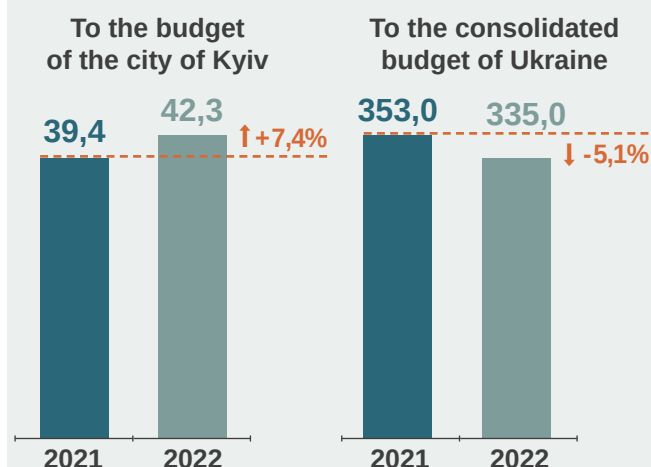

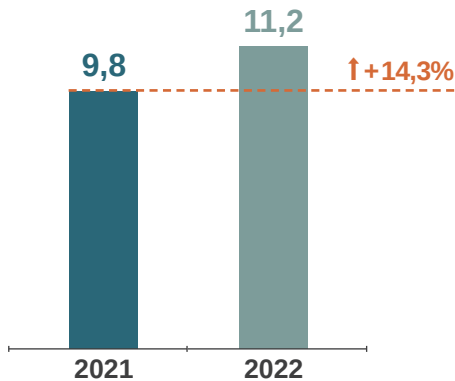

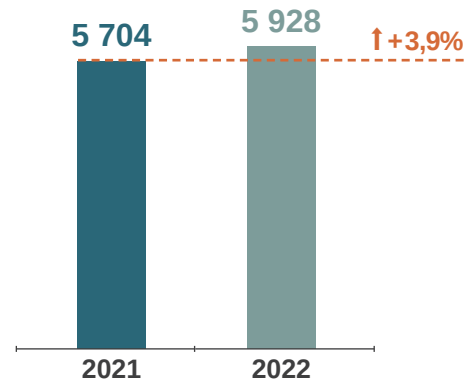

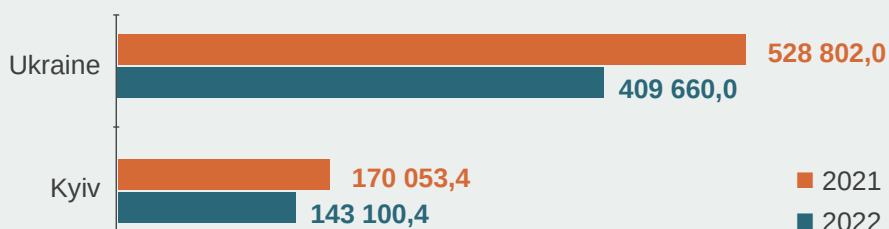

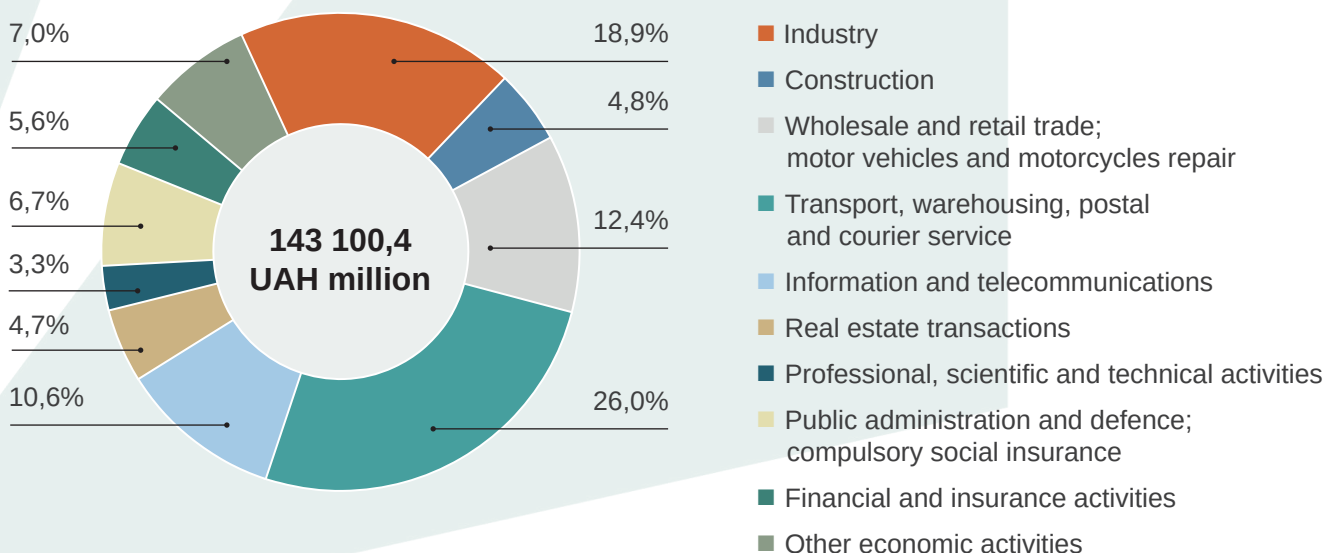

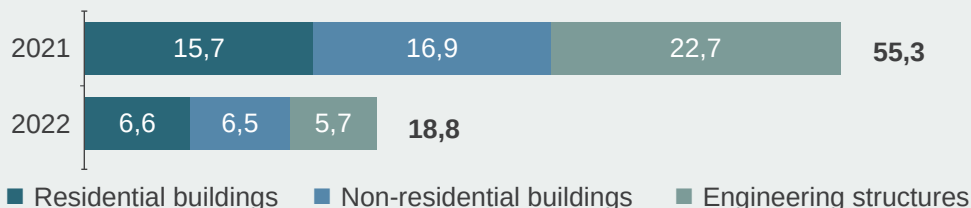

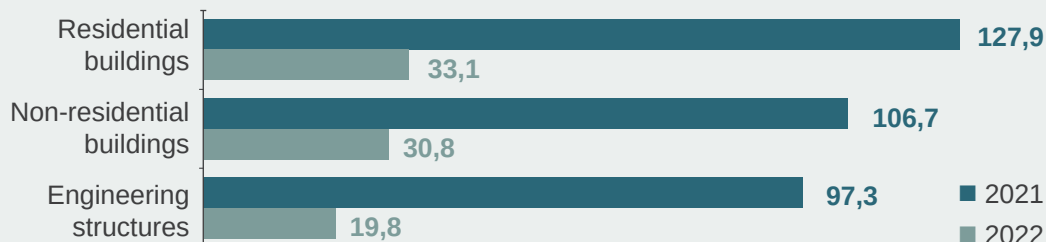

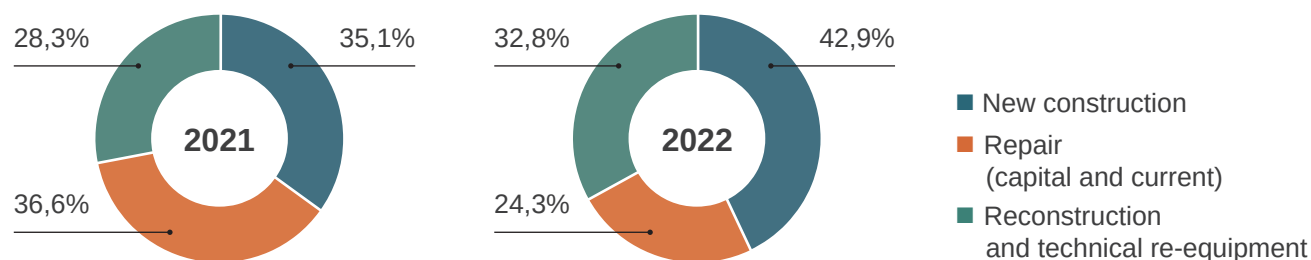

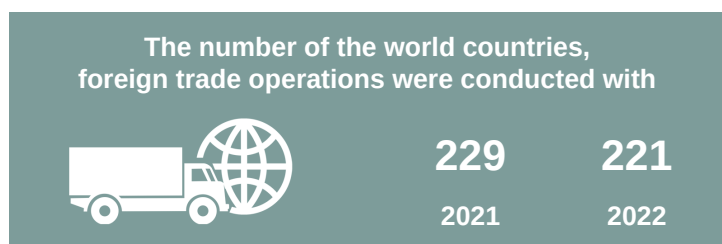

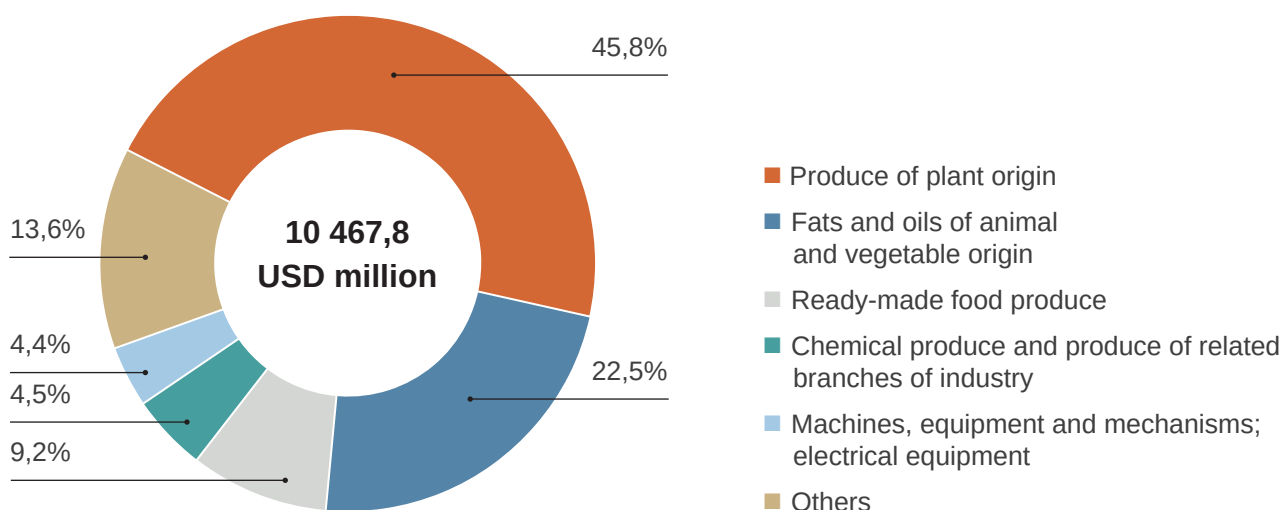

Main indicators of foreign trade in goods



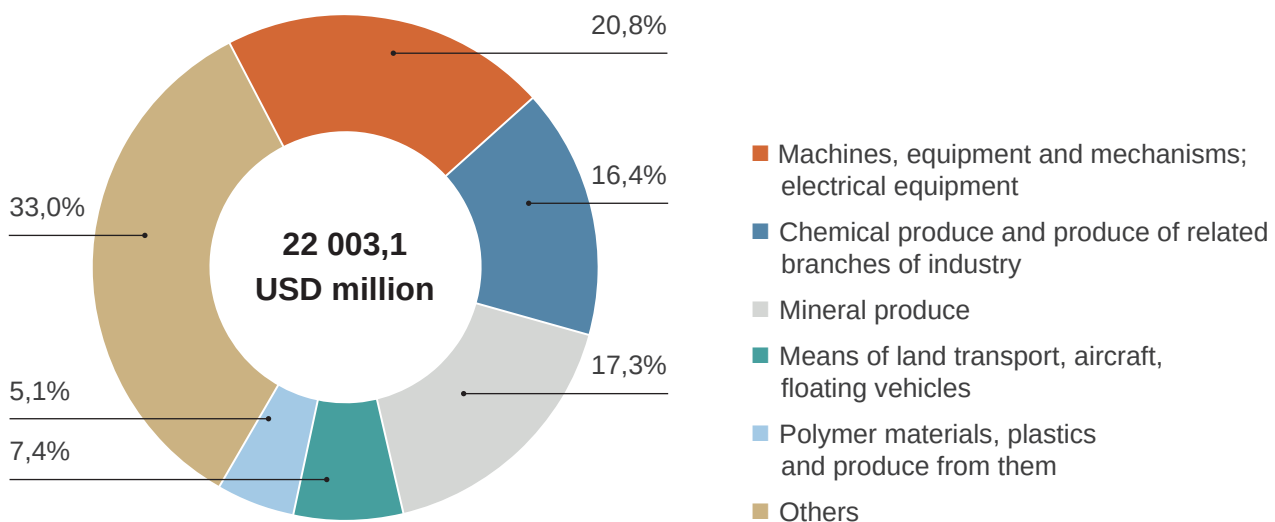
Export commodity structure, %



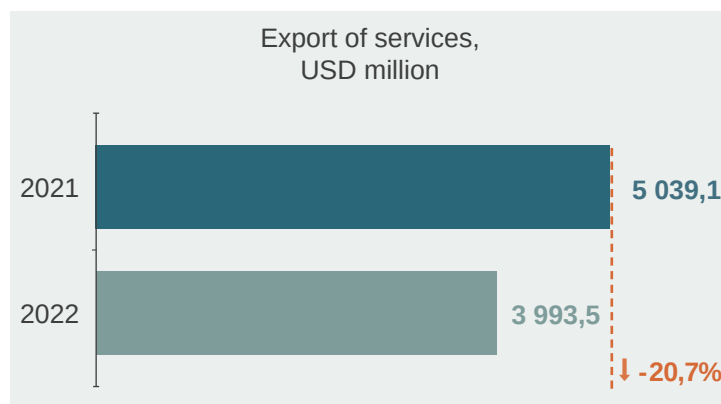

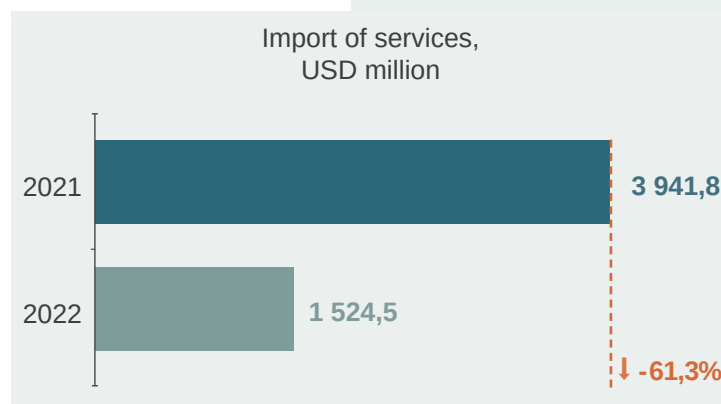
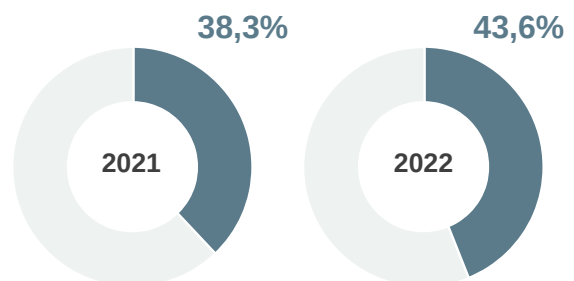

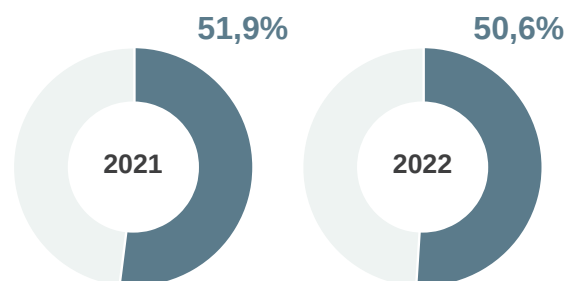
