

Dear friends,

Here is a publication about the third year of our resilience. About 366 days of round-the-clock work by utility workers, educators, medical professionals, public transport drivers, and city authorities to support all of the city's systems. We supported the rear to help our defenders fight for the freedom and independence of our state. We maintained order on all fronts and remained steadfast in this struggle.

During the full-scale invasion of Russian Federation into Ukraine Kyiv has undergone a difficult transformation: the consequences of war and martial law have affected all areas of the city's economy. However, over the past year, we have gained valuable experience: we have learned to adapt to the conditions of uncertainty and the challenges of war and to plan for future development.

In 2024, the updated Kyiv City Development Strategy up to 2027 was approved. In cooperation with the community, business, authorities and experts, development priorities were updated and the next steps for the city's life in the context of war and post-war recovery were defined.

The city authorities continued to prioritise safety. To achieve this, shelters were built in schools, kindergartens and other social infrastructure facilities. Kyiv was under constant enemy missile and drone attacks. Unfortunately, the enemy also targeted educational institutions. Therefore, the safety of our children during the learning process remained a priority for the capital. Backup lighting, ventilation and Wi-Fi in shelters ensured uninterrupted learning even during alerts. This is very important, as most educational institutions resumed normal classes after a long period of online learning.

Helping the army is our primary duty. Over the past year, the city's resources have been directed towards supporting the security and defence forces that protect our capital and country from the occupiers. Thus, €10.1 billion from the city budget was allocated for comprehensive support to defenders and assistance to the security and defence forces. Kyiv sent 14 000 UAVs of various types, including Mavic, Mavic 3T and FPV drones, over 100 vehicles, electronic warfare systems, communications equipment and other necessary equipment to the front line. Special attention is paid to our defenders who have suffered serious

injuries as a result of hostilities. More than 40 Ukrainian soldiers with amputations were sent to Berlin for the provision of modern prostheses and rehabilitation. At the same time, we are working with German specialists to establish a prosthetics centre for military personnel and veterans at City Hospital No. 12.

In 2024, Kyiv strengthened social support and reintegration for veterans by providing them with a range of services, including housing, rehabilitation, career guidance, and so on. In May, the "Defenders' Portal" was launched in the capital. It provides direct access to all services that the city guarantees to Kyiv defenders, as well as their families and the families of fallen heroes. On the website, you can apply for 11 types of services in a matter of minutes, in particular annual, monthly, and one-time targeted financial assistance, as well as receive information on prosthetics, psychological support, physical rehabilitation, and guided tours for Kyiv defenders, their families, and the families of those who are deceased. The city has also promoted the integration of IDPs and ensured the inclusion and accessibility of the urban environment.

Despite the war, in 2024 Kyiv increased its potential for recovery and consolidation, as evidenced by high socio-economic development indicators compared to other regions of Ukraine. This gives us optimism about the prospects for development and the pace of recovery.

The city also paid considerable attention to strengthening the resilience of urban infrastructure, in particular the protection of critical infrastructure, cogeneration and the uninterrupted supply of heat and electricity to the capital's residents. Mobile boiler rooms were used to supply heat to medical facilities and residential buildings during the period of repair of damage to heating networks and damage caused by enemy attacks.

In spite of the war, Kyiv was implementing large-scale projects in the transport sector. In May 2024, the Podilskyi Bridge Crossing was opened to municipal buses and special transport. Since December, passenger cars and public transport have also been using the bridge.

This has significantly improved connections between the banks of the Dnipro and somewhat relieved traffic flows on the city's main roads. In addition, a renovated section of the Great Ring Road has been opened to traffic. Complex repairs to the tunnel between the

Demiivska and Lybidska stations and the reconstruction of the Dehtiarivskyi overpass have been completed. A new overpass has been opened at the intersection of Poliarna and Bohatyrskya streets. Work continued on the construction of a metro line to Vynohradar.


The medical sector was also developed: the Kyiv City Centre for Nephrology and Dialysis was renovated, and several medical facilities were equipped with modern energy-saving systems. A Rehabilitation Centre for Children with Disabilities and a renovated Primary Health Care Centre No. 2 were opened in the Darnytskyi district.

Kyiv is a capital of resilience and invincibility. Last year, 20 912 babies were born in the city. That is almost a thousand more children than in 2023. They are the best symbol of life and hope, of Kyivans' faith in the future of our wonderful city!

Kyiv stands strong. Kyiv is recovering. Kyiv is strengthening the spirit of freedom and Ukrainian statehood!















Number of types of services provided through the ASC




Average waiting time for an applicant in the ASC queue


READINESS STATUS OF VAULTS

READINESS STATUS OF VAULTS BY DISTRICTS, UNITS


















SAFETY OF PARTICIPANTS IN THE EDUCATIONAL PROCESS




















SITUATION ON THE LABOUR MARKET IN KYIV










INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION INDICES, %




PRODUCTION GROWTH BY MAJOR INDUSTRIAL ACTIVITIES, %










NUMBER OF REGISTERED INDIVIDUAL ENTREPRENEURS, THOUSAND PEOPLE






BUSINESS ENTITIES – TAXPAYERS IN KYIV, THOUSAND UNITS




REVENUES FROM BUSINESS ENTITIES, UAH BILLION





VOLUME OF CONSTRUCTION PRODUCTS MANUFACTURED BY TYPE, UAH MILLION








INDEX OF CONSTRUCTION PRODUCTS BY TYPE




DISTRIBUTION OF VOLUMES OF CONSTRUCTION PRODUCTS BY THE NATURE OF THE CONSTRUCTION






DIRECT INVESTMENTS (CAPITAL PARTICIPATION INSTRUMENTS) IN THE ECONOMY OF KYIV



CAPITAL INVESTMENTS IN THE ECONOMY OF KYIV, MILLION UAH




CAPITAL INVESTMENTS IN KYIV BY SOURCE OF FINANCING








KEY INDICATORS OF FOREIGN TRADE IN GOODS



KYIV'S SHARE IN UKRAINE




COMMODITY STRUCTURE OF FOREIGN TRADE IN 2024, USD MILLION




LARGEST PARTNERS IN FOREIGN TRADE OPERATIONS WITH GOODS IN 2024




